


## Pop art explosion

### Words You Need To Know

<b>pop art</b>	Art based on popular things of the time such as TV, celebrities, fast food, pop music and cartoons.
<b>primary colours</b>	Red, yellow, blue.
<b>layers</b>	Single sheets of material placed on top of each other.
<b>collage</b>	Creating a picture by gluing or fixing different materials onto a surface.
<b>background</b>	The area of the picture furthest away from you.
<b>foreground</b>	The area of the picture closest to you.
<b>texture</b>	The feel or appearance of your artwork.
<b>composition</b>	The arrangement of elements in your artwork.

- Name the primary colours.
- Sort and arrange materials in a collage.
- Create a piece of work in response to another artist's work.

Roy Lichtenstein was an American pop artist.

He became famous for his colourful pop art paintings and comic book style.

Lichtenstein used dots, bold outlines and bright colours in his paintings, just like comic books.

He also used different sized dots to make pictures look like they have the colour and texture of a printed comic book.
