



# Year 1 Art: Fish Weaving

## Weaving with paper

Words You Need To Know	
<b>weave</b>	Crossing threads or other long pieces of material over and under each other to form cloth.
<b>loom</b>	A frame used to weave.
<b>warp</b>	The threads which run the length (of the fabric) on the loom
<b>weft</b>	The threads which are passed across and through the warp to form a woven fabric.

<p>Weaving is a way of joining materials.</p> <p>People all over the world have been weaving for thousands of years.</p> <p>Paper can be used to create colourful weavings.</p> <p>Weavers add decorative details to finish their designs.</p> <p>Complementary colours lie opposite each other on the colour wheel. When they are placed side-by-side, they make each other look brighter.</p>
