Words You Need To Know

observe	Look closely.
pattern	An arrangement of shapes, lines or colours that are repeated.
print	A shape marked or pressed onto a surface.
stamp	A tool for making a mark on an object by pressing down.
line	A dot moving in space.
colour	How something feels when you touch it, for example, smooth, rough, bumpy, soft or spiky.
shape	The outward appearance of something.
materials	Anything an artist uses to create art.

Key Skills

- Draw lines of varying thickness.
- Use dots and lines to demonstrate pattern and texture.
- Experiment with different brushes
- Mix primary colours to make secondary colours.
- Use a variety of materials to print (cardboard, sponge, bubble wrap).
- Use a variety of techniques to print (rolling and pressing).
