



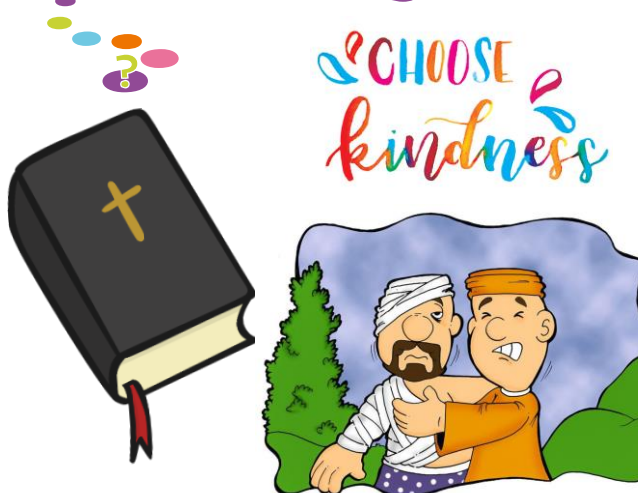
# Year 2 Religious Education: Christianity

Subject Specific Vocabulary	
<b>Christianity</b>	A religion founded in Israel around 2,000 years ago. Christianity is based on the teachings of Jesus.
<b>Christian</b>	One who believes in Jesus Christ and follows his words and teachings.
<b>Jesus Christ</b>	The central figure of Christianity.
<b>Bible</b>	The holy book of Christians.
<b>The New Testament</b>	The second part of the Bible containing 27 books.
<b>kind</b>	To be friendly, helpful or good.
<b>parable</b>	A short story with a lesson.
<b>paralysed</b>	Unable to walk
<b>priest</b>	A person who leads prayers or religious services.
<b>Samaritans</b>	A group of people who lived in a part of Israel.
<b>neighbour</b>	A person living next door or very near. Christians believe our neighbours are everyone we meet.

- ❑ The Bible tells stories about The Kind Man (The Good Samaritan, Luke 10: 25-37) and about Jesus healing the Paralysed Man (Mark 2: 1-12).
- ❑ Christians believe Jesus could be kind to everyone because God was helping Him. They believe He is God on Earth.

One of Jesus' most important teachings was 'Love your neighbour as yourself' (Mark 12:28-31). Jesus meant everyone is your neighbour.
