HOOK DAY

Monday 8th January 2024



Year R ... will be embarking on an adventure into the world of TERRIFIC TALES.

Children may come to school dressed as their favourite fairy tale character. Will the classrooms be filled with wolves, fairy godmothers or perhaps giants? We are excited to see!



Year 1 To Infinity and Beyond

Children will take part in the TVPS astronaut training including a VR workshop, opportunities to experience weightlessness in space and learning about the planets and our solar system. Children can wear anything space themed or their own clothes on this day.



Year 2 we will be looking at *Living Things* and their habitats. Children will get to explore the Flanimal Families books, create our own Flanimals and then make our Flanimals out of clay. Children can wear their own clothes on this day.



Year 3 will be looking at *Volcanoes*.

Children could wear a colour that represents Earth or Fire (e.g. yellow, orange, red, brown, black). The children will be taking part in a science experiment and for this we ask if your child could bring in any 200ml empty bottles. We would ideally like the children to make one model each.



Year 4 we will be looking at *Glorious Greece*.

We will completing a case study of Greece. As part of our hook day activities, we will be taste-testing a variety of Greek foods and looking at maps. We invite the children to dress in the colours of the Greek flag (white and blue) if they so choose. If not, they are welcome to wear non-school uniform.



Year 5 England's Monarchs

Sometimes, history is shaped by big events like battles or earthquakes. Sometimes, just one person changes things, like the Tudor King, Henry VIII. On our Hook Day, we will begin to explore the life and impact of one of England's most notorious monarchs. As we will be competing in a Tudor (PE) tournament for one of our activities, we would like the children to come in appropriate PE clothes but in the colours of the Tudor Rose - red, green, black, white and / or yellow/gold.



Year 6 are getting ready for our topic on Mexico.

We will be learning about Mexico, the physical and human features as well as weather and climate. We will be learning all about Mexican culture. For our hook day, children can come dressed in the colours of Mexico - red, white and green or anything Mexico themed.

Year 2 - Appeal for Shoe Boxes
