How does Victorian Britain compare to today?

English: Our class text this term is 'The Railway Children' which we will use to inspire us as we learn about diary writing and newspaper reports. Closer to Christmas, the children will learn about story writing using the classic Coca Cola advert, 'The Letter' as a starting point.

Reading: We will continue to delve into the worlds of Enid Blyton and Roald Dahl, continuing with The Enchanted Woods and the BFG.

Science

In term 2, our Science learning is all about our Light and Shadows. We will be learning about different light sources and how a shadow is made.

History

This term, we are learning all about the Industrial Revolution. With a focus on the invention of the steam engine, we will learn how it came about and just why it is of such importance to the world. We look forward to exploring what life would have been like for children working in factories and living in the industrial cities at the time.

Art and Design Technology

In Art, the children will learn about William Morris and his printed art works. After learning about him and his methods, the children will go on to make printed art of their own. In Design Technology, the children will be learning about Bridges. We will look at Isambard Kingdom Brunel's work and the children will try building their own bridges using craft straws during a DT workshop.

RE

Our focus in RE in term 2 is Christian festival of Christmas. We will explore what it means to different people, its vital importance to Christians and how people can celebrate it in ways that are special to them,
