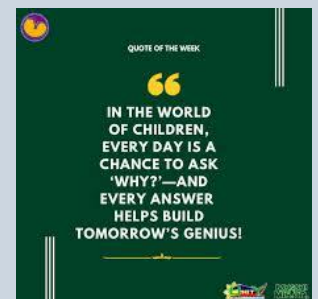

Super Stamp Challenge

In the newsletter each week a 'Super Stamp Challenge' will be set for the following week. The activity in this challenge is worth 3 stamps! Super Stamp Challenge - due 10.10.25

This week is in celebration of the England Women's Rugby team winning the World Cup last weekend.

To earn your 3 stamps, you must do the following:

- 🍌 1. Rugby Try Dash (1 stamp)
 - o Objective: Score as many "tries" as possible in 1 minute!
 - o Setup: Use a soft ball or rolled-up socks. Set up a "try line" using tape or cushions.
 - o Instructions: Run from one end of the room/garden to the try line and place the ball down. Run back and repeat!
- 🏃 2. Champion Circuit (1 stamp)
 - o Objective: Complete a mini fitness circuit like a rugby champion.
 - o Stations (can be adjusted):
 - **Jumping Jacks** - 20 reps
 - **Ball Passes** - Pass a ball back and forth with a partner or wall
 - **Sprint & Stop** - Run to a marker and freeze
 - **Victory Pose** - Strike a winning pose!
- 🗣️ 3. Rugby Moves Memory Game (1 stamp)
 - o Objective: Learn and repeat a sequence of rugby-themed actions.
 - o Example Sequence: Jump like scoring a try. Run on the spot. Pass the ball. Cheer "Go England!"
 - o Instructions:
 - Watch or hear the sequence, then try to repeat it in order.
 - Add one new move each round!
