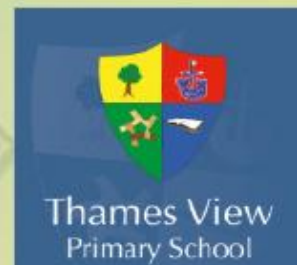

What is Children's University?

Children's University is an opportunity for every child to be recognised for the amazing things that they take part in outside of school hours. Children are recognised for the skills that they achieve through these activities. All children from Year R through to Year 6 are involved!

Children earn stamps for every hour of a club or workshop that they complete at a place recognised by Children's University. They must log these onto the Children's University website on their account - details will be shared next week. ***It is your child's responsibility to log their hours onto the website.***

Children will then be invited to attend a graduation in the July to celebrate their cumulative hours/stamps accrued. We celebrate everyone achieving 30 stamps or more.

Where can children earn their stamps?

Every afterschool club that takes place at Thames View automatically includes 1 stamp for every hour completed. If a club includes a performance, then they will get stamps for the total time of the experience. Some of the places in Medway and wider south east where children can earn points are found below:



In Medway and surrounding areas:

- Pets at Homes workshops.
- Lego Clubs at Medway libraries.

Currently in the process of being signed up:

- Razzamataz Drama School
- Wildwood Trust
- Shorne Woods Country Park
- Medway Academy of Performing Arts
- And many more...

Please note for places such as Chessington and Legoland there are specific tasks for the children to complete whilst there. Sadly, just going on the rides does not count!

My child attends a club, but it is not listed here?

Don't worry! Your child can still earn stamps for what they attend outside of school, but we need the provider to fill out a short online form to allow for us to quality assure the experience.

Send the club/experiences email address to

childrensuniversity@thamesviewprimary.medway.sch.uk and I will send across the welcome pack with the link to the form with them.

My child does not attend a club, will they be excluded from this?

No, not at all. Every half term a list of 6 activities that your child can complete at home will be provided such as a cooking challenge, gardening and other key skills. This half terms activity sheet will be sent home with your child's login details next week and can be completed up until the end of the term.
