Today, we have enjoyed the Big Football Day! Children have been enjoying football tournaments throughout the day, with many wearing their team kits to cheer on their teams. Opportunities for Sport are very important to us at Thames View and we want to give all children the opportunity to try different sports and see what they enjoy. We continue to follow the standards of the Gold Mark Award and look forward to our sporting celebration evening in July.


