We have had our first Hook Days of this year on Tuesday and Wednesday, a reminder of topics can be seen below. I have also been seeing the Hook Day Boards come to life, these are the display boards for each year group to showcase their new topics, pictures will follow on social media next week when we judge our winning year group!

Topics for this term are as follows;

Reception-Terrific Tales (looking at the adventures of fairy tales)

Year 1- The Space Race (learning about Space with Virtual Reality and visiting the Planetarium)

Year 2- Ocean Explorers (learning about our oceans and the creatures who live there)

Year 3- Volcanoes (looking at how a volcano forms and erupts, including erupting their own volcanoes)

Year 4- Glorious Greece (Looking at the geography and culture of Greece)

Year 5- England's Monarchs (Looking at the Tudor King, Henry VIII)

Year 6- Mexico (looking at the home and physical features of Mexico including weather and climate)

Our first virtual reality workshop of 2025, as part of our computing curriculum, is scheduled for the 14th January. This will allow our year 1's to journey through space. Then on the 29th, year 3 will be having their Virtual ECO Workshop to learn about sustainability, linking nicely to our ECO initiative and our Green School approach. Year 1 will also be going to the Greenwich Planetarium for a closer look at our Solar System and to watch a live planetarium show on Wednesday 15th!

Young Voices is happening on the 20th with the most students we have ever had attending to represent Thames View from a range of year groups. We also have a range of sporting events happening that week, including an EFL football tournament and Mini Youth Games, if your child is attending, you will receive a letter from Miss Bailey!



Hook Day Pictures


Please ensure that you walk on the footpaths to and from the Club for the safety of your children and yourselves.
