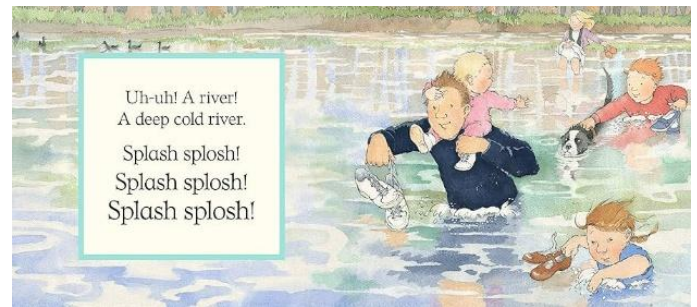


# ... Hook Day - Tuesday 4th November 2025 ...

## Year R - We're going on a Bear Hunt !

The children can wear their own clothes and bring in a Teddy bear (not just a soft toy please) for the Bear Hunt



## Year 1 - Transport - from the Wheel to the future

We will be travelling through history to look at how transport has evolved from cavemen inventing the wheel through to exploring what the future of transport might look like. Children can come to school dressed as someone who works in transport such as a train driver or pilot, some clothes that represent a country from around the world or in their own clothes.

## Year 2 - “Changes within Living Memory - Toys & Books”

This special day will help children explore how toys and books have changed over time. To make the day fun and memorable, we would love your child to dress up and/or bring something to school.

We are looking forward to a fun and interactive day where the children will explore toys and books from the past and compare them with those of today.



## Year 3 - Victorians



Following on from our recent visit to Kent Life, the children are invited to dress in Victorian clothes or in clothing that is navy, blue, brown, black, grey or white to reflect the colours of Victorian times. Throughout this term, the children will be learning about life in Victorian Britain, with a particular focus on the Industrial Revolution and the question: How did new technology change Britain? This learning will also link to our Science topic of light.

## Year 4 - Mountains

We will be learning about “Magnificent Mountains” this term. We invite the children to dress up as a mountain climber or in clothing the colour of mountain ranges (earthy colours - grey, brown, white). We will be creating a mountain themed music piece as well as mountain artwork and locating the Seven Summits of the world using mapwork skills.



## Year 5 - Ancient Egypt

Year 5 will be travelling back thousands of years to Ancient Egypt to explore the gory process of mummification! We would love children to dress up as Ancient Egyptians and, if possible, bring in an apple to mummify!

## Y6 - WW2

To launch our WW2 we will imagine what it would be like to be a child at the time, learn some popular games from the era and experience some of the popular music of the time. Also they will enjoy taking part in code breaking challenges and even pretend to be an evacuee. It is going to be a brilliant day. Come in your own clothes or dress as a child from wartime
