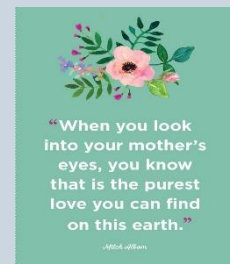

Topaz were the class to beat with a tower standing at an impressive 191cm tall!



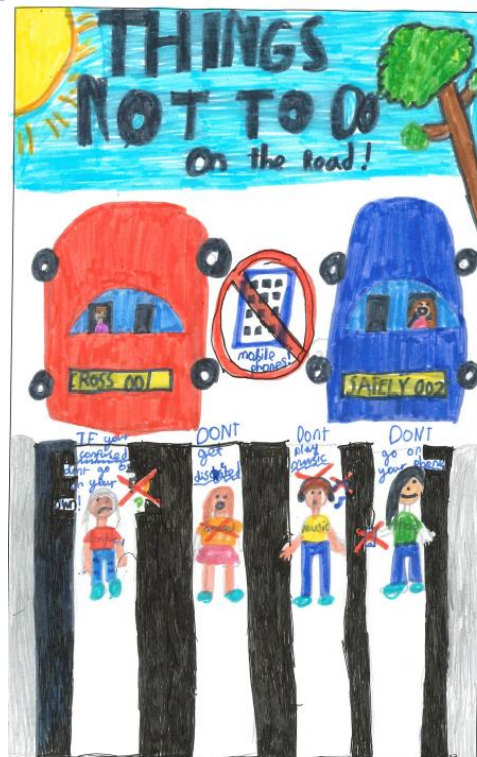
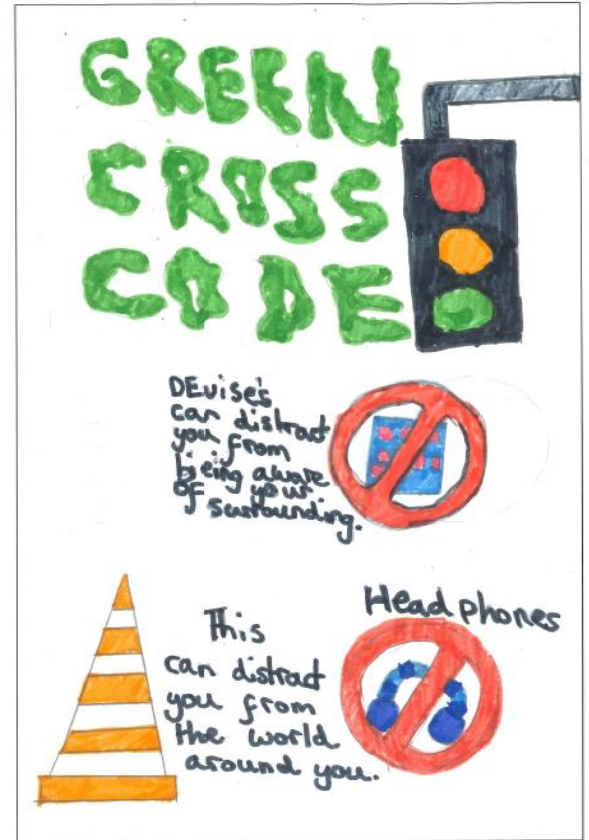


Year 4 - Lego workshop
