Head Girl: Katie

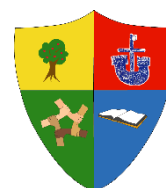

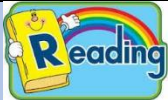

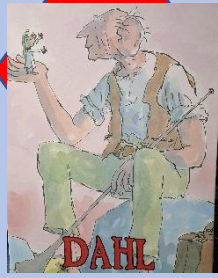
