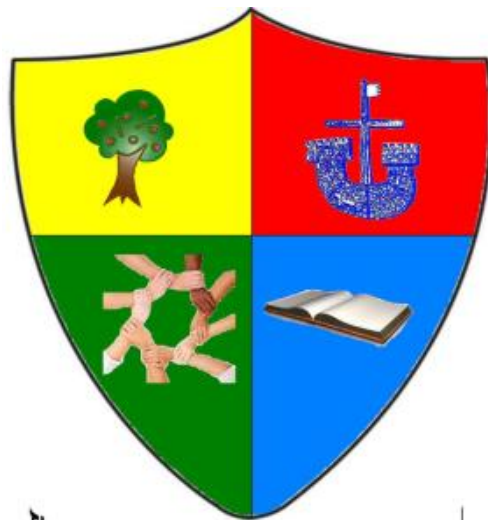




Thames View Primary School
