Dear Parents/Carers,

As we approach the end of what has been, yet again, an extremely challenging academic year, we begin the process of planning for September.

Today you will have received information regarding the outcome of the School Day Organisation Consultation. I am writing to notify you of some further changes for next year at Thames View.

We will sadly be losing three members of staff, who are moving on to further their careers in other Medway schools from September.
