#### **School Uniform**

Our school colour is navy.

Book bags and PE bags can also be ordered from Tesco on-line and these will have the school logo.

#### The school uniform consists of:

- ✓ White shirt (or polo shirt), navy sweat shirts, jumpers, cardigans and fleeces. These can all be ordered with the Thames View logo.
- ✓ Grey trousers, shorts, skirts or pinafore dresses
- ✓ Summer dresses are navy and white.
- ✓ Black, sensible shoes.
- X Nail varnish, hair dye and patterns shaved into short hair and novelty head bands are not permitted, ie. Animal ears, unicorns and large bows.

#### PE Uniform consists of:

- ✓ Navy shorts and t-shirt for indoor PE and warmer weather outdoors; you may wish to buy a t-shirt in the colour that matches the House that your child is in. (Aldington yellow, Bodiam blue, Hever green & Rochester red)
- ✓ Tracksuits and trainers are required for outdoor PE when it is cold or wet.
- ✓ Plimsolls can be worn for indoor PE or outdoors when it is dry. Gymnastics lessons are done in bare feet.

A second-hand School Uniform Shop displays items in the Main Entrance. It's always worth checking this before you buy new as the uniform is in very good condition. We ask for a donation for items of clothing obtained from the School Shop.
