Dear Parents/Carers,

As we come to the end of Term 3, I am wondering what challenge we will have to face next!

I do know that the Government are currently considering seven different options regarding how schools will return to some sort of normality from 8th March. Schools have been promised two weeks' notice of any new arrangements, so I <u>hope</u> to be able to inform you about what will happen in Term 4 at Thames View, on Monday 22nd February.

Monday 22nd February is a scheduled Staff Development Day, therefore remote learning will resume for the majority of children, and school will re-open for Vulnerable children and those of Critical Workers on **Tuesday 23rd February.** If your circumstances change and you longer require a place for your child/children, please contact the office <u>office@thamesviewprimary.medway.sch.uk</u>

Thank you once again for all your hard work and perseverance in engaging your child/ren in their learning this term – I appreciate how difficult this has been for everyone. We have managed to keep in touch with most children/families on a regular basis, but continue to be concerned about some of our children who have submitted limited or no learning via Edmodo, and where parents have been extremely hard to reach. We will be contacting these families via letter over half term.

We have been asked once again to be part of the Contact Tracing programme during the school holiday. Therefore, if any of the children or staff who have been in school on 11^{th} or 12^{th} February test positive for COVID-19, between $12^{th}-14^{th}$ February, please contact the school office to enable us to inform parents/carers to Self-Isolate for 10 days, if your child has come into close contact with the infected individual.

I would like to say a **HUGE** thank you once more to all the children, parents/carers <u>and</u> staff for their incredible resilience and hard work again this term. I wish you all a very relaxing half term break so that you can return refreshed for whatever Term 4 throws at us.
