# Hook Day - 6<sup>th</sup> September 2023



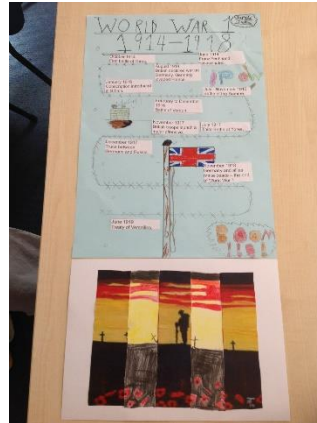

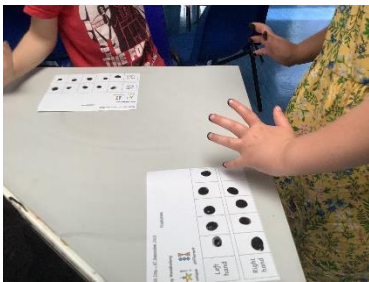
