These trips will be happening between September and January. Letters will be sent to each year group with specific dates and more information!

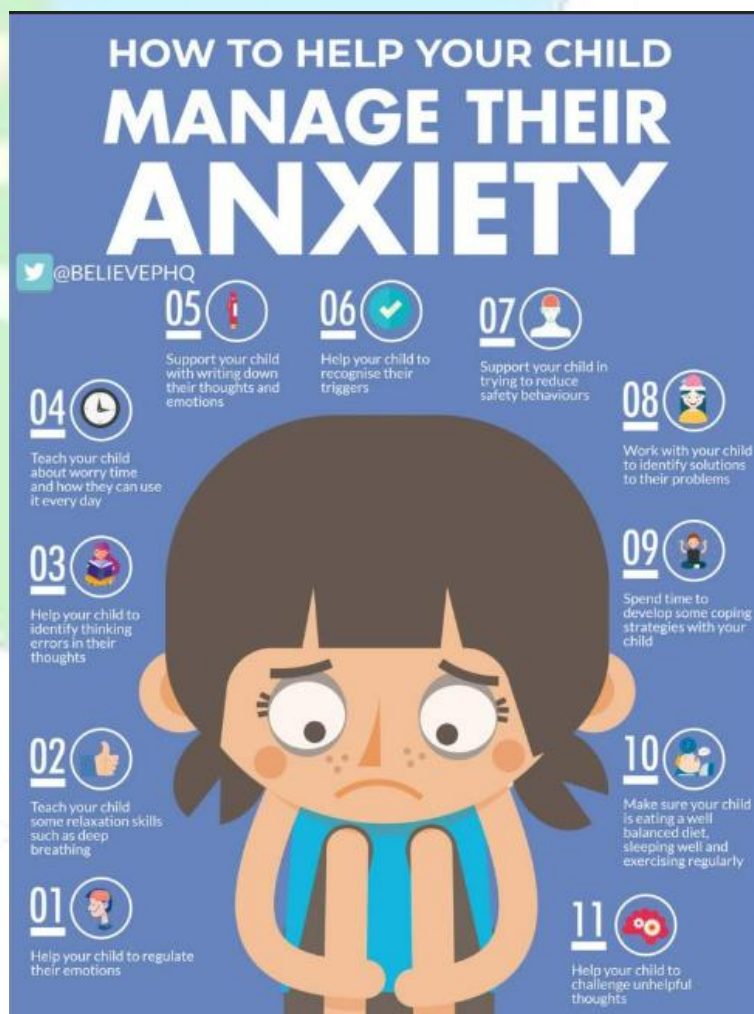
