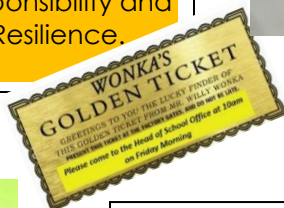
We will be supporting the NSPCC Number Day. The children can come in with “number” clothing for the day - this will be a non-uniform day.

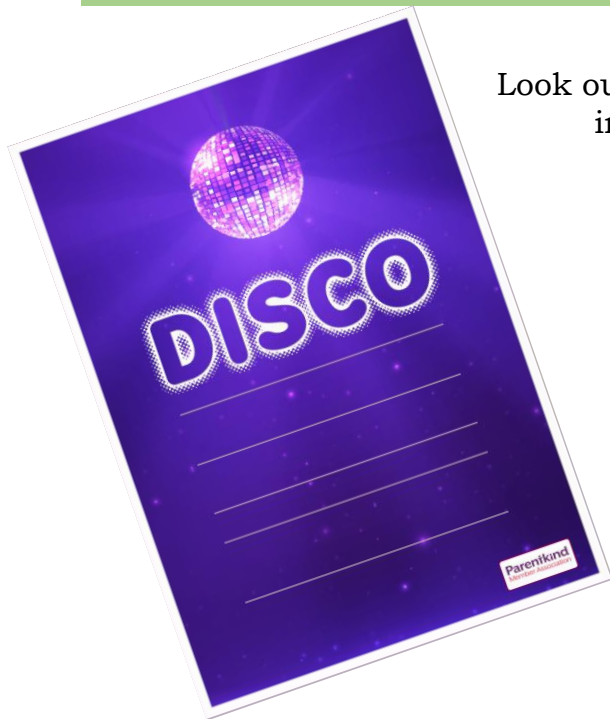
