Mrs Rogers Message

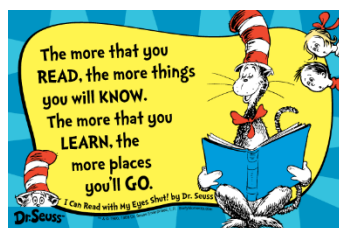
